**RM** Great handy ways of working, you see.

**BK** Aye (surely).

**RG** Turn on (the light), they feed themselves. They clean themselves.

BK Mm-hm.

**RM** I would spend longer there footering about with them lock round in the back house.

**RG** Oh, dreadful.

**RM** (No) (XX) (way of working)

RG Och.

**BK** These cattle sheds (with them) and them standing on the slats,

RM Aye.

**BK** if it agrees with them. Some of them surely they go lame on them but, uh,

**SM** See (were/where) a man lost seven cows.

**BK** Where?

**RM** Stewartstown.

**BK** With gas?

**RM** Mix-, mixing slurry, aye.

**BK** Huh-ho.

RG Seven?

**SM** Aye, seven cows (XX)

**RM** Valued at five thousand pound.

BK Mm.

**RG** (Boys) that's wild.

**BK** Oh, this old slurry is a dangerous job.

**RM** Aye. Calhouns down at Omagh told me that they were mixing it and it was an outside house,

**BK** Aye.

**RM** there was no roof on it,

**BK** Aye.

RM (it was) an outside slatted yard and - they seen the bullocks starting to

**BK** Aye, to stagger.

RM lean again other.

**BK** Aye.

**RM** It's lethal. You could kill yourself too with it.

**BK** (XX) oh, aye, surely because it does-

MM (Will you) take a drink of tea, will you?

**BK** It doesn't smell.

RM No (no I'm only) after tea.

**RG** All you need's the two breaths.

**BK** It doesn't smell.

RM Uh-huh.

**RG** It neither smells tastes nor anything else.

BK No.

**RG** And all you need's two - to inhale two twice.

**BK** Aye. Two puffs.

**RG** (That's what the doctor said)

BK Mm-hm.

**RG** That's enough.

**BK** Well, now, somebody was stirring the slurry and they lit a cigarette and they threw down the match and the whole head of it just went off in a flame.

RG Yes.

**RM** Oh, aye, you see (you've the) gas.

**RG** You're warned to not strike any lights (in the yard/so you are).

**BK** Well, that man might have, it might have saved him for he burned it off.

RM Mm-hm.

**RG** (It's) a dangerous handling.

**BK** But that man could - could he have been smothered with that

RM Oh, aye.

**BK** or was that only a wee bit?

**RM** The time Wesley had the cow, do you mind?

**RG** Aye, I was there.

**RM** Sure didn't the vet tell him that if he had've been a lock of more minutes it'd've been yous'd've been down too.

**RG** Uh-huh. And only, only for him that day, for I says to him, says I, we'll let this milk away we'll go in and take our dinner.

BK Mm-hm.

**RG** So just had turned round.
