hated Latin, so...

KPC Do you think you got that a bit from your cousin, Josh?

MWEm, Josh was very clever and he, he was very good. He, em, was

> very good at Art, and very good at most things. I kind of benefited a little bit because if one of the cousins could be clever, and he was

two years ahead of me, so... a year and a half, so...

KPC So you didn't have to be?

MWNo. They expected it of me, so they... there was a, that sense of,

> 'You, your cousin's good enough. You must be. So stop messing about and concentrate.' And all my reports always said that...

KPC Mm.

MW... – 'Peadar's a daydreamer. Always will be. [laughs]. If you

catch him on a good day, you could see he's clever. If you don't,

then forget about it.'

KPC [laughs] **MW** Em, so that came across... all my reports were the same. My

mother... my father really wanted us to go University and to break this working-class, not being able to get out of Derry, mould.

KPC Mm.

MW He...

KPC So that was a big motivation for you, then, do you think?

MW Yeah. He taught me stuff when I was a kid, walking on beaches and

stuff, about...

KPC Mm.

MW ... all round the world and peoples, and, 'Don't stay in Derry. Get

away and see it all. And then if you want to come back, come back and stay. But if you want to stay away, there's nothing wrong with

that either.'

KPC Mm.

MW Em, my mother didn't help. She, she told me from a very early age

that I wasn't quite one of the family, because I never quite fitted,

that I was a gypsy and they, they got me from the gypsies.

KPC [laughs]

MW And if I misbehaved, they'd put me in a children's home.

KPC [laughs]

MW Which was 150 yards up the street, the Nazareth House was just up

the street.

KPC So you'd be close to home?

MW My sister came for me one day to take me. [laughs]. I was, I think

I was about, I must have been about 10. I was old enough to know

better, but Monica...

KPC [laughs]

MW ... our Monica is, was the other mischievous one. Monica came and said something like, she called me away from my friends and says,

'Peadar,' and I was, 'What?' She says, 'You have to go to the children's home now.' I says, 'What?' She said, 'You have to go and stay in the Nazareth House for a while. We don't have enough money to feed everybody'. And we were a big family, and I thought, 'Right,' I thought, 'Okay, em, em...' 'No, you don't need

MW Oh, aye. Yeah. Our Monica was, was great. She...

KPC What else did she do to you, do you remember?

MW She... Monica used to be able to fight the boys.

MW The big boys. Monica... if anybody, any of the big boys bullied me,

Monica would just go out and flatten the big boys, even Dom

McCartney, and he was, he was a big...
