Well, years ago you used to have the old beds with the iron bed-posts. And we used to put up, um, corners of these bed-posts, um, have four corners and then we'd tie four more on the top to make a roof. But they were only, um, bars across. They weren't, they didn't go from, they didn't cover, like, they weren't a sheet or anything, they were only bars. And then we would put up sticks o-, f-, across from one bar to the other and then maybe whin-bushes on the top of that. And, or maybe if we'd old bags we'd put them up on it. Um, and we would maybe put a few sticks round the side to, and we would build a fire and boil eggs in a tin and we would put, um, whin flowers into the water and that turned the eggs a great yellow colour.
